- Assure our environment performance data in our BRSR report by a third-party assurance provider.

- Reduce our GHG (Green House Gas) emissions and stay committed to emission intensity ambitions of 2030.
- Make continuing efforts in modernizing our fleet with next-generation, fuel efficient aircraft.
- Evaluate opportunities to deploy Sustainable Aviation Fuel (SAF) and take actions as may be required.
- Maintain best-in-class noise abatement performance in line with the ICAO requirements.
- Improve the emission profile of our ground operations through usage of electric vehicles.
- Minimize usage of single-use-plastic throughout our operations.
- Adhere to the best practices in recycle and reuse of waste materials.
